Literacy and Maths

In maths, this half term, we will be learning about place value, addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. The children will also be working on their times tables.

In Literacy, we will be writing non-chronological reports, diaries, biographies and narratives all based on our topics and books we will read as a class. We will also be completing weekly topic-based grammar and reading comprehensions which will develop our understanding of the different genres.

Topics

Week 1 & 2: Bienvenue (MFL- French)

For our modern foreign languages topic, we will learn simple greetings, phrases and numbers. We will find out about France and write about famous landmarks and tourist attractions.

Week 3 & 4 : Where in the World (Geography)

In geography, we will be looking at the physical and human features of our local area, we will go on a field trip and create our own sketch maps.

Week 5 & 6: Let's Get Rocking (Science)

In science, we will discover how fossils are formed and learn about different types of rocks and how they are made.

Week 7 & 8: Prehistoric People (History)

In our history topic, we will be studying the Stone Age. The children will learn about how people survived during this time and how their lives changed from being hunter-gatherers to farmers.

Religious Education

This half term, we will be focusing on the Christian Value of responsibility in our assemblies, class worship and prayers. We will also be studying what Christians can learn from the story of creation in our weekly RE lessons.

Physical Education

This half term, our indoor PE will have a dance focus. We will be working on linking movements to create our own dance routines and sequences. Outdoor games will be skills-based ball games involving throwing, catching, running and jumping.

Computing

We will be using ICT to learn about and use branching databases. We will also be developing our coding skills and learning how to keep safe online. We will use the computers to develop our topic knowledge and improve our keyboard skills.
