Literacy and Maths

Reading and Writing – Writing opportunities will be linked to topics and the children will write for different purposes. This half term they will be covering non-chronological reports, posters, recounts and writing narratives with a familiar setting.

Daily phonics and spelling sessions will be taking place alongside daily reading.

Maths – This half term we will be focusing on multiplication & division, fractions of amounts and shapes and learning the time to the nearest 5 minutes. Year 2 will be working on their times tables and division facts for 2x, 5x and 10x.

Topics

Week 1, 2 & 3: Brazil

In this Geography topic, we will be looking at basic geographical language to refer to human and physical features. We will be using a range of resources to locate and name continents, capital cities and countries. We will understand the similarities and differences of the UK and Brazil.

Week 4: Easter

Year 2 look at the importance of the importance of the Easter story and the season of Lent.

They will sequence the Easter Story and know the events of Holy Week.

They will take part in Easter celebrations. They will understand the meaning of the word Salvation.

Week 5: Remember Remember Week

In this week, we recap on all of the sticky learning so far. We create, revisit, explore and ask questions about the topics we have completed in the Spring Term.
