If you no longer want to take part in a sport please let the coach know and if you want to add a sport just go along to the training and let the coach know you'd like to join.

This year, taking into account that it costs around £10 per child to train and participate in the Saddleworth Village Olympics we are asking people to make a suggested donation of £10 to help towards the costs.
